


### **BUNDIYARRA**





- 3. The Aboriginal Cultural Complex will drive wealth through job creation and provide a financially sustainable future for the Corporation and many other local Aboriginal agencies.




### THE LEARNING JOURNEY

Since February 2016, Bundiyarra has assisted more than one hundred (100) Aboriginal and non-Aboriginal people receiving Centrelink benefits through our Jobactive programs.

### **FACT**

- 1. Seventeen (17) participants through Work for the Dole, Jobactive programs at Bundiyarra, have secured part time employment at Bundiyarra within Environmental Health Services, reception, marketing, book keeping and supervisor roles.
- 2. Three (3) have secured employment with outside agencies.
- 3. Steady growth will continue as more infrastructure is completed.


With 3 kids, and the cost of living, Bonnie and I went into anxiety mode.





### **OVEN CLEANING**


- 1. Sprinkle Bi-Carb on stained areas.

- 3. Wipe it off.... It's that simple





Allow to sit for ½ hour then flush



### Clean your whole house for \$150 per year with white vinegar and bi-carb soda!





What happens when you mix bi-carb soda and vinegar? In this reaction, bi-carb acts as a base, and takes a proton from vinegar, which is an acid. The reaction releases gas because when the bi-carb soda receives the proton, it transforms into water and carbon dioxide.


### Why does vinegar work as a cleaner?

Acetic acid or white vinegar is a great disinfectant. It also acts as a deodorizer and cuts grease. And you can tackle household bacteria like salmonella, E. coli and other "gram-negative" bacteria with vinegar.

### Is vinegar disinfectant?

Vinegar can be used as a safer bleach alternative for some applications, like cleaning. It is also biodegradable.
