 <p>76 million people still live in extreme poverty</p>  <p>EHPs are key in enforcing legislation relevant to safe housing conditions and improving slums/low socioeconomic areas</p>  <p>EHPs enforce safe living condition requirements like air pollution levels, waste management and sanitation</p> 	 <p>EHPs ensure access to safe, nutritious and sufficient food all year round for all people, in particular the poor and vulnerable populations</p>  <p>A lot of work is done enforcing food safety regulations throughout the food manufacturing line, from producers to restaurants</p>  <p>EHA provide food safety training for EHPs to ensure safety within industry</p> 	 <p>7 million people die every year from exposure to fine particles in air pollution</p>  <p>Almost 1/4 of all deaths every year are linked to environmental factors that EHPs work to prevent</p>  <p>EHPs ensure healthy lives by enforcing health standards and promote well being practices throughout communities</p> 	 <p>6/10 children and adolescents are not achieving a minimum level of proficiency in reading and maths</p>  <p>EHA provide accreditation to university environmental health courses to support the profession</p>  <p>EH Officers work to improve access to basic services in communities and free up children's time to attend school</p> 	 <p>Over 5 billion people have access to safe drinking and recreation water thanks to the work of EHPs</p>  <p>80% of the world's wastewater still goes into waterways without adequate treatment - EHPs play a major part in regulating sanitation</p> 	 <p>98% of agricultural products undergo industrial processing, monitored by EHPs</p>  <p>EHPs ensure infrastructure meets strict regulatory guidelines</p>  <p>Resilient infrastructure is overseen by EHPs so livelihoods are protected from natural disasters</p> 	 <p>EHPs work within communities to ensure equal and fair use of natural resources</p>  <p>EHPs work with indigenous communities to ensure they are receiving the same health care services and living standards as those living in large cities</p> 	 <p>EHPs promote sound urban planning to reduce pressure on the environment and nurture sustainable lifestyles</p>  <p>EHPs work in and encourage renewable energies leading to sustainable cities</p> 	 <p>A major role for EHPs is to reduce and regulate the release of chemicals and waste into the environment</p>  <p>EHPs monitor all waste services to make sure toxic and harmful waste/pollutants are disposed of safely</p>  <p>EHA is proudly involved in the National Return of Unwanted Medicines (NatRUM) project to keep our environment free of unused medicines</p> 	 <p>EHPs work to strengthen resilience and adaptive capacity to climate-related hazards and natural disasters in all countries</p>  <p>EHPs work in developing innovative solutions to the production of crops affected by climate change</p>  <p>EHPs aid in disaster recovery from severe weather events and in public safety during pandemics like COVID19</p> 	 <p>EHPs aid in mobilising resources, sharing knowledge, promoting the creation of environmentally sound technologies, building capacities and tracking community progress</p>
